Our Environmental Studies major is a unique opportunity to pursue multi-disciplinary environmental scholarship and gain practical experience in the spectacular ecosystems of the Great Basin and Sierra Nevada.

Curriculum features

- Integrates all fields of environmental study, from art history to wildlife ecology
- Draws on courses across all colleges and most departments in the University
- Students work with top researchers on environmental issues
- Independent research combines with field study and real-world problem solving opportunities
- Double-major requirements ensure interdisciplinary breadth with depth of expertise in a chosen field

Double-major/dual concurrent degrees

Environmental majors have three degree options:

- Double-major within the Bachelor of Arts degree
- Double-major within the Bachelor of Science degree
- Dual concurrent degree: a Bachelor of Science plus a Bachelor of Arts in Environmental Studies

All Environmental Studies majors must first declare a departmental major before being admitted into the program.

- Any major degree program at the University of Nevada, Reno qualifies as a departmental major
- The departmental major determines the degree program and curriculum design for each Environmental student.
- Students with a departmental major in the arts, humanities or social sciences will pursue a curriculum concentrating on science and policy
- Students majoring in science fields will be oriented toward the arts, humanities and social science

University of Nevada, Reno's Environmental Studies major is a unique opportunity to develop well-rounded experts who combine insights from the arts and humanities with scientific understanding to address the environmental challenges of the 21st century. This rigorous double major program is one of the few truly multidisciplinary environmental studies curricula in the nation.
